Funding & Scholarships



Studying abroad in a foreign country is an experience of a lifetime. For this reason, it is important to plan ahead and consider the costs and options for financial support in advance to enjoy this time to the fullest. Tuition fees, living expenses, foreign health insurance and additional costs are different in every country and institution, but you can apply for financial support for places all around the world.

Once you have decided to study abroad, various financial possibilities may apply. You should consider applying to internal university scholarships such as PROMOS; you can apply for ERASMUS+ when studying within the EU; or you could check out the HAW International Scholarships if you are considering completing your thesis abroad (and are enrolled at a university of applied sciences). For all these financial support options, we would recommend to contact your home institution for more information.

Another major financial contributor could be the governmentally funded Auslands BAföG – it is crucial to start your plan early on and explore your options to ensure the most beneficial financial support possible. This very lucrative governmental support is available to a lot of applicants and offers funding for tuition fees as well as additional assistance for living expenses. In addition, the *Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst* (DAAD) keeps an extensive scholarship database, with many different options. The variety of financial support opportunities in Germany is quite large in order to give everyone the chance to enjoy an experience abroad to the fullest.

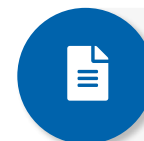
